Re: Covid-19 Delta Variant – Polite Reminder

As we break up for the summer holidays, please remember the recent communication from our Local Authority Health & Safety advisers:

“We have become aware of an increase in cases of Covid-19 in schools in the Vale. A few of these have already been confirmed as Delta variant. The Delta variant of Covid-19 is estimated to be 40-80% more infectious than other strains and some symptoms can be slightly different from previous variants that were circulating in the UK. Delta variant is now the most common variant identified in new cases in Wales.

Because the Delta variant is more infectious, it is really important everyone is aware that there is a rising risk of Covid-19 in our local area.”

We hope you all have a wonderful, happy, and safe summer break. I'm sure that if we all remain cautious and vigilant, we will be able to have all the children back in September fresh and hungry for new learning and challenges!
