What a wonderful week of learning we've had across our lovely school. Here are a few of the highlights...

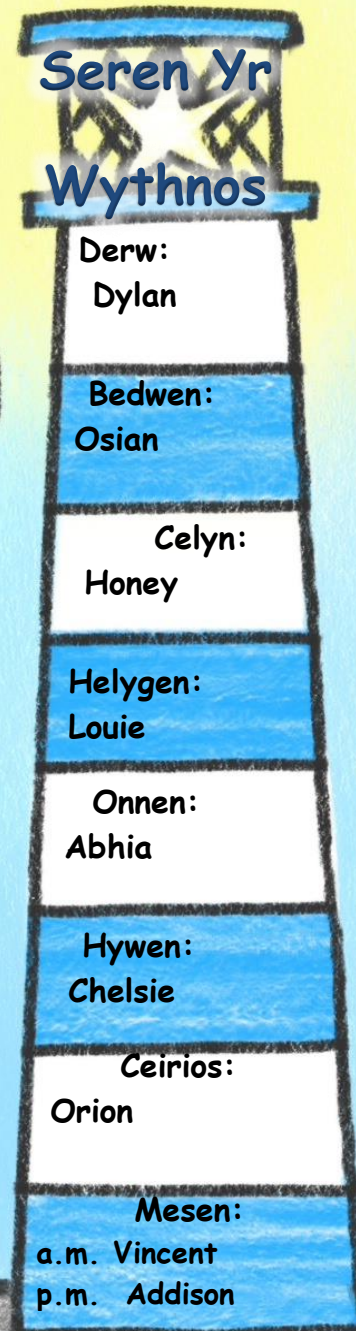
